

## **COLLEGE OF DIETITIANS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA**

### Case Outcome Report #07-03 - Competence

In October 2007 the College received a complaint against a Registered Dietitian from two colleagues relating to competence with nutrition support assessment, implementation, monitoring and record keeping.

The Inquiry Committee investigated the report in accordance with Part 3 of the *Health Professions Act*, Inspections, Inquiries and Discipline. This included review and discussion of the complainants' letters, the registrant's letter of response, a Chart Review of pertinent client records and the Investigators' Report. Soon after the investigation had been completed, the registrant, on the registrant's own initiative, completed a refresher course on the theory and practice of nutrition support. Although the Committee determined that at the time of the investigation the registrant's practice did not meet acceptable standards, a final decision was made six months post-course after a detailed on-site assessment of the registrant's practice was conducted.

The Inquiry Committee met on November 5, 2008 to consider all case documentation including the on-site Assessment Report and standards for nutrition support competence. In accordance with section 33(6)(a) of the *Health Professions Act*, the Inquiry Committee resolved to take no action against the registrant as all aspects of nutrition support practice meet current standards.
