Registration renewal by March 31

The 2009/2010 online registration renewal process is available **Wednesday, March 4** until the **March 31 deadline**. This includes renewing your registration and submitting your fees as well as submitting your Restricted Activities verification forms (Appendix 1 or 2) by fax, email or mail. You will be asked for your **User ID and password** to access your profile and renew your registration online. Please contact CDBC if you have any difficulties. Please note: the \$500 annual fee and \$25 Restricted Activities fees have not been changed since the CDBC's inception in 2004.

What does your CDBC fee pay for?

The fee entitles you to **practice your profession** and use the protected title of **Registered Dietitian** for the April 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010 year. It is the College's main source of funding which provides the means to meet the public protection services and processes required under the Health Professions Act. The fee is in line with the other larger Canadian dietetic regulatory colleges: Alberta's fee is \$525, Quebec's \$595 and Ontario's \$500.

April 1, 2009: "Grandparented" registration class converts to "Full"

As of April 1, 2009, Full (Grandparented) registrants will have their registration status converted to Full Registration. The main purpose is to clarify registration classes for labour mobility. **Would you like a new Full Registration certificate at no cost?** Please contact the office.

New CDBC committee appointments
